1. Call to Order and Roll Call
Action: Meeting was called to order at 2:06PM. A quorum was established.
2. Mindfulness Moment
Action: Carolyn Curtis led the mindfulness moment.
3. Public Comment on Non-Agenda Matters
Action: Walter Wyniarczuk gave kudos to Julie Gallelo on her updates given at previous meetings regarding Commission happenings.
4. Approve Draft Action Summaries of November 17, 2017 & February 9, 2018
Action: Curtis/Wyniarczuk. Approved as recommended. Angelina Woodberry abstained from the vote.
5. Child Death Review Team Presentation & Fetal/Infant Mortality Report
Action: Stephanie Biegler and Jasmine Hill Wilson presented the PPT presentation to all in attendance. Some points presented were:
 - ✓ African American children were 24% of all child deaths and 10% of Sacramento County child population.
 - ✓ CDRT found a statistically significant correlation between a history of CPS referral and ISR death at a 99% confidence level.
 - ✓ Fifty-five percent of all child decedents had past or present family involvement with a CPS agency.
6. Approve Appointment of Silvia Rodriguez – Mental Health Board
Action: Silvia was introduced to all in attendance and committee members were in agreement to forward her approval to the May 2018 Commission meeting.
7. First 5 Commission Director's Report
 - Update on Trauma Informed Approaches**Action:** Julie Gallelo presented highlights of the Commission meeting and an overview of trauma informed approaches, which included:
