

First 5 Sacramento Commission Advisory Committee Member Recruitment Fact Sheet

The First 5 Sacramento Advisory Committee is a technical advisory body to the First 5 Sacramento Commission. The Commission is responsible for the allocation of Proposition 10 funds (cigarette tax money) for projects and programs serving children 0-5 and their families. Approximately \$12 million is generated annually for Sacramento County children and families as a result of Proposition 10.

First 5 Sacramento funding is focused on seven areas with the following goals:

1. To decrease African American child death
2. To decrease dental disease
3. To improve breastfeeding rates
4. To increase access to affordable childcare
5. To increase quality practices in early care and education settings
6. To increase school readiness for kindergarteners
7. To increase use of effective parenting skills/decrease child maltreatment rates
8. To increase family participation in community activities

As a technical advisory body to the Commission, the Advisory Committee's responsibilities include:

- Reviewing and making recommendations on the strategic plan and updates.
- Participating in an integrative approach to the RFP process, including development of the initial RFP.
- Facilitating and participating in the first level of review of proposals.
- Advising the Commission on activities and issues that area aligned with its mission.
- Providing special advisory functions related to emerging issues.

Advisory Committee Accomplishments

- Conducted review of proposals submitted during the 2018-2021 Strategic Plan period for the seven result areas above.
- Provided input on the Commission's Priority Result Areas and Strategic Plan.
- Community Survey to identify priorities of Sacramento County residents regarding needs of children 0-5.

Current Advisory Committee Activities

- Serving on the Evaluation Committee, Financial Planning Committee and Sustainability Committees.
- Updating the Commission on Advisory Committee Activities.
- Advising the Commission on emerging issues.
